Program delivery

Concerts in Care (CiC) will deliver a series consisting of _____ *Concerts in Care* (45-minute live music programs) between _____, 2019 and _____, 20____.

The programs will generally consist of a mix of solos, duos, trios, and quartets.

The musicians will be chosen by CiC from the ranks of professional performers and those that are entering professional performance careers and have been recommended by professionals.

Each Concerts in Care series will be scheduled on a regular day or evening, and time, with exceptions for special days, events, etc.

Force majeure

a) CiC recognizes that viruses and other enforcements of closure of seniors' care facilities to the public will result in postponement of programs. The Facility will agree to reschedule postponed programs at mutually acceptable times.

b) CiC will work to accommodate to reschedule programs. Failure of CiC to deliver a program as a consequence of artists' failure to appear for any reason waives the contribution unless the program is rescheduled.
